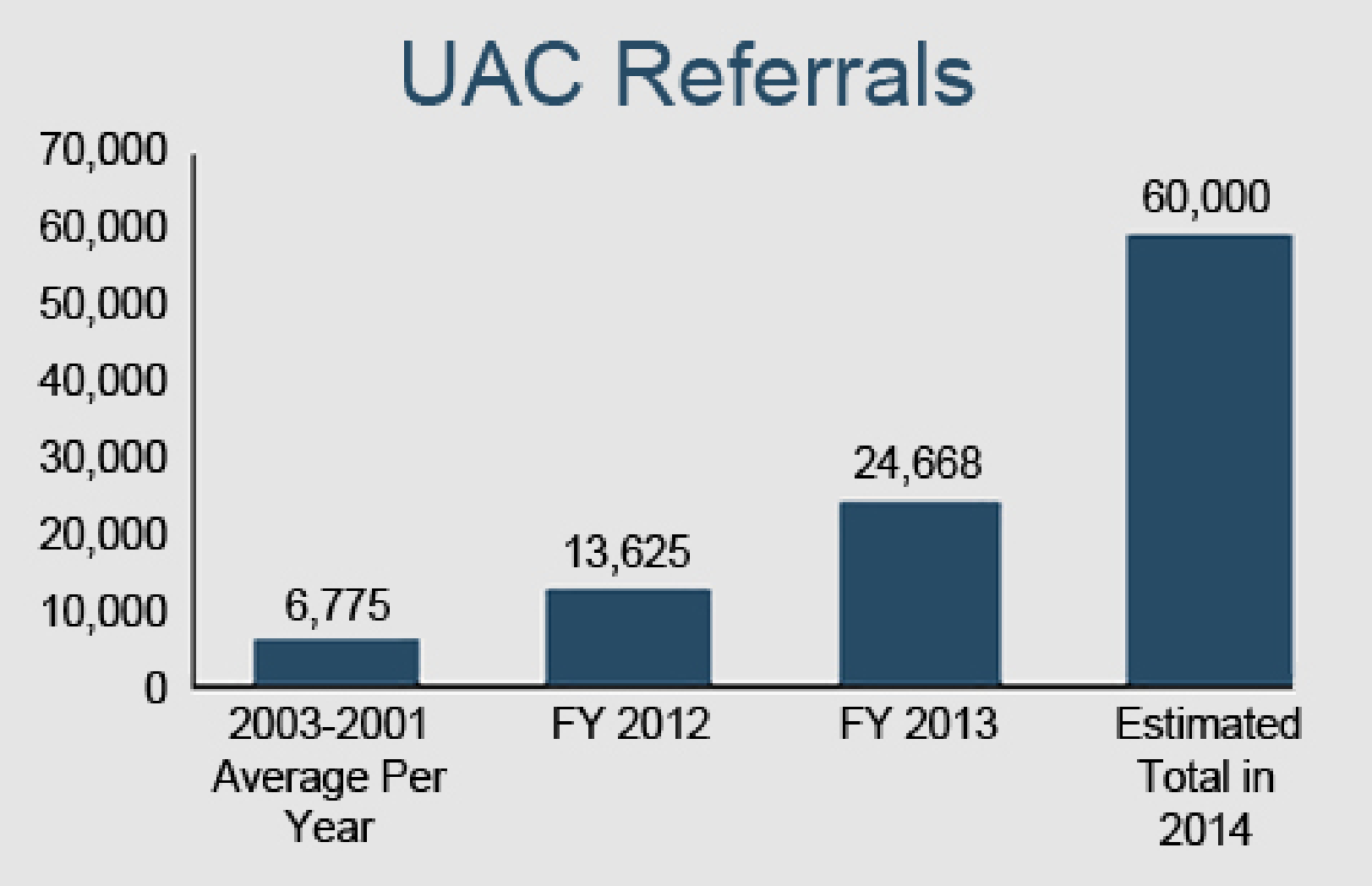

FUNDING FOR UAC PROGRAM

Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) posted by the ORR

ORR seeking residential care providers to provide beds for the UAC Program

Providers must be licensed by a state agency for residential, group, or foster care services for dependent children

Applications are due by August 5, 2014

Providers with 50 beds are ideal, but the FOA is flexible on this due to high need

POLICY UPDATE

SB1252: THP-Plus for 36 months for youth enrolled in school

- Passed out of Senate; heard in Assembly Human Services on 6/17
- Clarification: extension to age 25, not age 26
- Is a county option- start talking about it!
- Send in letter of support

AB2668: \$200 extra for parenting youth in SILP

- Passed out of Assembly; heard in Senate Human Services on 6/17

SB1023: Support for foster youth in community college

- Passed out of Senate; heard in Assembly Human Services on 6/17
- Amended in Senate to limit to 10 community college districts, which would serve about 3,000 students

AB2001

Passed out of Assembly; heard in Senate Human Services on 6/17
