Child Welfare in the Governor's Budget

- Realignment
- Continuation of Veto
- THP-Plus

THP-Plus Budget Update

- Proposes to cut THP-Plus by \$19 million in FY 2011-12
- Budget rationale: 18 & 19 year olds will have access to THP-Plus Foster Care through AB 12

Impact of Proposed Cuts to THP-Plus

- Makes 1,000 youth homeless: reduces capacity to 998
- State loses \$9 million in federal funds
- Leaves vulnerable youth without an option
- Undermines goals of AB 12

Budget Advocacy

- Sign-on letter submitted January 20
- Assembly Budget Subcommittee hearing held on January 27th
- Next hearing date: Senate Budget Subcommittee February 8th

THP-Plus Allocation for FY 2010-11

- Released on January 7, 2011
- 2009-10 allocation is base
 - New counties in 09-10 funded at 100%
 - New counties in 10-11 funded at 50%
 - Veto applied evenly
- Available at <u>www.thpplus.org</u>
- Essential that program funds expended by 6/30/11

 - Training & Informing
 - Administration & Fiscal
 - Rules of Court
